In West Fork Cane Branch there also has been an improvement in the ground cover that would indicate a slight decrease in sheet erosion from woodland and idle land areas. The main locale of sheet erosion, however, remains on the old prospect areas in the West Fork. In Cane Branch, the situation is much the same as described for the other two watersheds.
