Book Description: This book opens up Twelfth Night as a play to see and hear, provides useful contextual and source material, and considers the critical and theatrical reception over four centuries. Students are encouraged to imagine the theatrical challenges of Shakespeare's Illyria afresh for themselves, as well as the thought, creative responses and wonder it has provoked. : Shakespeare Handbooks are brand new introductions to the plays. The heart of each volume is a commentary that leads a reader through the text showing how its words come alive in performance and what needs to happen on stage as its action unfolds.
